# What to bring to school

On Friday 25<sup>th</sup> August First Years will **only** need to bring the following **clearly labelled with their name**:

- Device that Wriggle will have delivered to you (you may wish to consider putting a protective cover on this before your first day in school). <u>Please ensure that the device is fully charged before arriving</u> to school on the first day and then leave the charger at home so that it does not get lost.
- Two Copies (no particular number of pages).
- Pencil case (with basic supplies, for example: pens, pencil, sharpener and eraser).
- Spiral key chain (or key ring) to keep your locker key safely (perhaps attached to pencil case or uniform).
- **<u>Reusable water bottle</u>** and a snack for break time.
- You will be bringing books home with you so you will need to bring a school bag plus an additional supermarket bag for this!



From Monday 28<sup>th</sup> August onwards please bring the same as above but include your lunch. Then over the next few weeks teachers will explain what you will need to bring each day.
