Dear Parents/Guardians,

We want to let you know about two items relating to traffic that are pertinent to our school community.

Firstly, you may have noticed that there are signs up about road works starting outside the school gate from next Monday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Tipperary County Council have informed us that the roadworks on the Coleville Road are for the installation of a 2m wide footpath from the East of Loreto to Dudley's Mills. We believe that this will, in the long term, be very useful for students who walk to and from school.

While these road works are ongoing can we ask that parents/guardians use the car park at Suir Island and students walk across the bridge to school.

Secondly, we are delighted that our school has been selected to participate in the Safe Routes to School programme, which is designed to enable students to safely walk, cycle and park & stride to school.

As part of the initial phase of this programme, the Safe Routes to School Team would like to gather information on how our students travel to school and where they start their journey.
