Latest up-date from the DES

The Department of Education and Skills (DES) has published *Calculated Grades for Leaving Certificate* 2020 Guide for Schools on Providing Estimated Percentage Marks and Class Rank Orderings (see this link).

This publication says that the document, issued by the DES at the time of the Minister's announcement, A Guide to Calculated Grades for Leaving Certificate 2020 (see this <u>link</u>) should be read before the above Guide for Schools.

On page 2 and 3 of the Next Steps section it says:

- 3.3. To support the technical administration of the Calculated Grades model, the following is being established:
- An on-line system for students to personally confirm their final entry level for each subject in which they are entered. This will be launched shortly.
- 3.6. Information for students and parents/guardians on Calculated Grades for Leaving Certificate 2020 is being prepared and when available, will be published on the website www.gov.ie/leavingcertificate

We will let you know when the on-line portal opens and when the information for students and parents/guardians is published – at present we do not have a date for this.

I look forward to being with you all, albeit apart, at your Graduation Mass next Wednesday night at 7pm.
