Dear Student and Parents/Guardians,

As we enter phase 2 of the government's roadmap for reopening society and business, we have the opportunity to enable students who have left books/equipment in school to collect these and for everyone to return locker keys. In advance of this phase, our ancillary staff have completed a deep clean of the school.

To do this safely, we propose to do the following:


- Students who brought everything home with them should POST THEIR LOCKER KEY BACK TO SCHOOL
- Students who need to call to school will book an appointment to come to school. We intend to bring students into school over two days, Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June and Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June following guidelines regarding covid-19 etiquette and social distancing.

## • Procedure for students posting keys to school:

- Please use BLOCK CAPITALS and write your name, year group and your locker number (if you remember) on a page.
- Wrap key(s) inside this page and place in an envelope.
- On the top left hand side of the envelope write for example  $6^{th}$  Year Locker Keys and then address the envelope (with a stamp) as follows:

Keys should be sent in the post no later than: Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2020

- Procedure for students coming to school to collect books.
  - o **1**<sup>st</sup> **Years and TYs** make an appointment with **Fiona (SNA)** using chat in teams **(fionaryan@loretoclonmel.ie)** to attend school Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June or Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June
  - o **2**<sup>nd</sup> **Years and 5**<sup>th</sup> **Years** make an appointment with **Dolores (SNA)** using chat in teams **(doloresgill@loretoclonmel.ie)** to attend school Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June or Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June
  - o **3**<sup>rd</sup> **Years and 6**<sup>th</sup> **Years** make an appointment with **Sandra (SNA)** using chat in teams **(sandraburke@loretoclonmel.ie)** to attend school Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June or Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June
  - o If you can, please wear a face mask as you approach the school building. There are lots of YouTube videos on how to make your own one example is <a href="https://example.com/here-are-lots-of-weath-new-approach
  - Please bring your own hand sanitiser. Just outside the school building please use this to clean your hands. We will be using our own sanitiser from our own homes also. If we don't see you doing this, you will not be permitted inside the building. Should you wish to bring gloves to use, directly outside the school building please use the sanitiser first and then put on fresh/new gloves
  - Bring your locker key(s) with you to school and also a suitable bag for books/equipment etc.
    (perhaps a suitcase on wheels might be useful)
  - o Follow all HSE guidelines regarding covid-19 etiquette and social distancing.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Years and TYs will wait for Fiona at the front entrance and follow any directions she gives regarding getting to lockers (and coat hook if needed)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Years and 5<sup>th</sup> Years will wait for Dolores at the rear entrance beside Room 8 (Ms Boyd's room) and follow any directions she gives regarding getting to lockers (and coat hook if needed)
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Years and 6<sup>th</sup> Years will wait for Sandra at the rear entrance beside the 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Toilets and follow any directions she gives regarding getting to lockers (and coat hook if needed)
  - Only one person, preferably the student, may come into the school
  - Students are asked to be very prompt and limit their time in the building.
  - o Students are asked to sign in BRING YOUR OWN PEN and then go straight to your locker
  - We will not be in a position to dispose of unwanted materials, so you need to take everything home
  - Lost property from the Sports Hall will be on the tables in Tinsley Hall (there will be no access to the Sports Hall)

Lost keys will result in a replacement cost of €10 euro per key. Locker allocation for next year is dependent on the return of the key or payment for a replacement of the key.

**Please note:** if anyone in your household is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, high temperature, sore throat, runny nose, breathlessness or flu like symptoms now or in the past 14 days) we would ask that the student or family members do not present in school.

Post your key to school and you can collect books another time.
