- All 1st, 3rd, 5th and 6th years for normal classes
- All 2nd Years for normal classes
- All TYs for Induction Day

Arrangements for Monday 7th September 2020

• Normal classes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th and 6th Year and first day of Work Experience for TYs

Arrangements for Tuesday 8th September 2020 to end of week

- Normal classes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th and 6th Year
- TY Bonding Day
