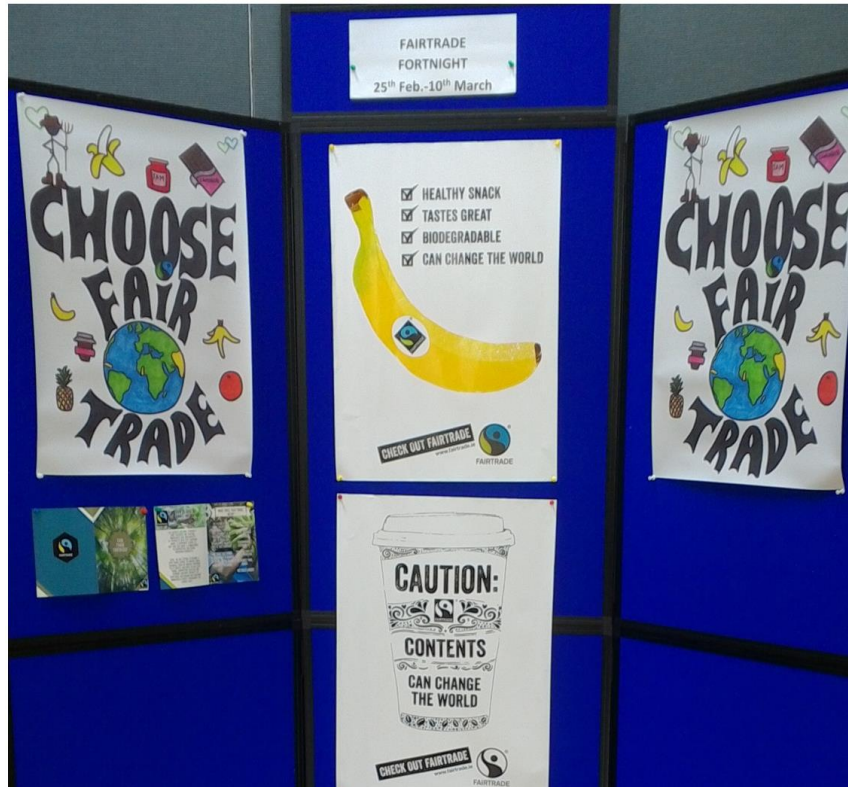


## Becoming a Fairtrade School



This year our Development Education Group committed to work to make our school a Fairtrade School.

Our canteen is now serving Fairtrade tea, coffee and bananas and our staffroom is also using Fairtrade tea and coffee.

During Fairtrade fortnight, 25<sup>th</sup> Feb.-10<sup>th</sup> March, every class in the school received a lesson on Fairtrade from the Dev. Ed. Group. Each class took part in a quiz on Fairtrade and every student had a chance to sample Fairtrade chocolate. The staff enjoyed a Fairtrade 'coffee morning' during their morning break.

Our Model United Nations was running during the first week of Fairtrade Fortnight, so the Dev. Ed. Group organised leaflets and stickers for the packs of around 200 delegates from other schools inviting them to join us in making their schools Fairtrade too.
