

Explanation of Expenses

1. Personal Accident Insurance

This is a cover for each individual student for any accident which may occur, at any time and in any place during a year. The school has its own insurance cover but in many accidents there is no negligence e.g. a fall from a bicycle at 9.30 p.m. on an August evening, or an accident at games. This insurance covers each individual for 24 hours a day for 365 days, beginning on 1st September each year. Each student is expected to avail of this personal accident insurance.

2. Photocopying & Stationery:

Teachers give students many pages of photocopied information and tests during the year. Stationery for Christmas, 'Mock' and Summer Examinations will be supplied.

3. S.P.H.E.:

All 2nd, 3rd, 5th & 6th Year students study S.P.H.E. & Careers.

The money goes towards the cost of guest speakers and materials used in class.

4. Student Journal:

The Loreto Student Journal contains School Rules, Policies, Code of Discipline etc., as well as a Daily Diary and other useful information.

5. Home-Economics (Scientific & Social): 2nd, 3rd & 5th Year students. The Dept. of Education and Skills has discontinued the grant for Cookery Classes.

6. Retreat All 3rd, 5th and 6th Year students will have a one-day Retreat.

The retreats are facilitated by professional experienced personnel. As such, it is an integral part of the school ethos.

7. Careers:

All 5th & 6th Year students study Careers.
