Dear Parents/Guardians and 6th Year Students,

We write to you following our meeting with 6th Years today to update you about Leaving Cert examinations for our 6th Year Students. We will write separately to you about our return to **in-person schooling** for 6th years.

Written Leaving Certificate Examination Dates

These have been published (*see page 2*). These will be conducted subject to public health advice and providing, as far as possible, access to the examinations for very high risk students.

Additional assessment components, such as orals, practical performance tests and coursework will run, subject to public health advice with components in certain subjects not running for public health reasons. Assessment will be arranged by the State Examinations Commission (SEC). As we have more information about this we will keep our students updated.

An Accredited Grades system

This will be operated by the SEC. It will be available whereby Leaving Certificate candidates can opt to have grades in some or all of their subjects (to be known as "SEC Accredited Grades") issued to them. However it is important to note that **only one** result will be issued – whichever is better i.e. Accredited Grade or Written Leaving Cert Grade.

What does this mean for our students?

We acknowledge the difficulty of this situation for our 6th Years. We know that this is an incredibly stressful time for you and your family. Our students will be asking what does all of this mean for them! We also know our 6th years will be wondering should they take an Accredited Grade or sit the exam in June?

We cannot answer this question for any student as personal circumstances will be different for everyone. We believe that this will be an individual decision for each student supported by their family.

LC Orals and Music Practicals

Students may wish to consider undertaking the oral and practical exams which are likely to be during Easter or the first week after Easter.

Mock Exams

As sitting the written exams in June is now optional, here in Loreto this means that the Mock Exams, *if they go ahead*, will also be optional (and outside of school tuition time). We will send a survey to our 6th years later today to see what Mocks (if any) they would like to take and from that information we will decide if we will run Mock Exams. We also wish to clarify that if the Mocks go ahead these results **will not** be used for Accredited Grades.

Like yourselves we have many more questions and together we will learn more about the process.

You are all in our thoughts and prayers as you make decisions over the next few weeks.
